Include what he is famous for, some key events from his life, when these events happened.</li> <li>2. Write a list of items you would need to explore Australia, e.g. the desert, rainforest or coral reefs.</li> <li>3. Create a story board to tell the story of the Gun Powder plot with images and words.</li> <li>4.
