Message from the Headteacher

It has been a super week in school with so much learning activity. I have the pleasure of listening in each morning to a small Reception phonics group which takes place in the corridor outside my office at 9am. Then throughout the day, I hear the Nursery staff working one to one with our very youngest pupils on interventions to develop their speech and language skills. The Pastoral Team is based next to my office and the team are in and out continuously working to support parents and children through a vast range of adverse childhood experiences and social, emotional and mental health challenges. The dedication of these teams and the attention to each individual child would astound you.

I am always proud to show visitors around the school. This week the Headteachers from several local secondary schools complemented us on the calm, hard working classrooms and particularly our smart uniform.

Year 5 have had Sky Blues in the Community for a PE initiative and thanks to our Community Policing Team, our very own Junior PCSO scheme is up and running at Templars with 10 children from Year 5 being trained to tackle some of the challenges we are facing at school including the dangers of dropping off and collecting children from school, bullying and litter. Year 6 have been to the Bletchley Park Museum, the home of the Codebreakers to supplement their learning on the Second World War. Today, I have had joined in the fantastic Young Voices experience with 110 children from Year 4 and the Young Voices Choir at the NEC. This trip is second to none and a once in a lifetime chance to be a performer.
