Next Week is Careers Week and World Book Day on Thursday so two opportunities for dressing up. It's fun to dress up but we respect those who don't wish to and we certainly don't expect any expensive shop bought costumes. Research has shown that the younger children are exposed to careers information, the better their school outcomes and therefore the wider their opportunities are, when they do enter work.

Unfortunately, Mrs Wall has had to cancel this year's parent-led Careers Fair that was due to take place on Monday afternoon (3rd March) because only two parents volunteered. However, our very friendly builders are going to be allowing the children to have a go at a number of activities including brick-laying this week and Mrs Wall has organised activities for all year groups.

Community Centre developments - you will have noticed that the building works are coming along on time and we are starting to plan how we can use the space. Six workstations are being put in so that we can take the children for proper cooking lessons. Lots of outside agencies have been in touch and would like to use the space to provide some super services for the community: Stay and Play sessions, Baby Clinics, Baby Massage, Library sessions, Women's Health among others. New fencing will allow us to create a larger outdoor area for children who need a smaller lunchtime provision and allotment plans are being sought. Exciting times!
