You could draw pictures and write some facts about each event or time period and when they happened: The Big Bang, Stone Age, Bronze Age, Iron Age, Ancient Greece, Ancient Egypt, Romans, Anglo Saxons, Vikings, Tudors and Victorians. -Research and write a diary entry as if you are a time traveller that has come across a Roman Settlement. -Create a model of a Roman Villa including huts. Use materials you can find in your recycling! -Create a map of Europe and locate the 5 countries in Great Britain and locate as many countries in Europe as you can. -Romans were famous for their appetites!
