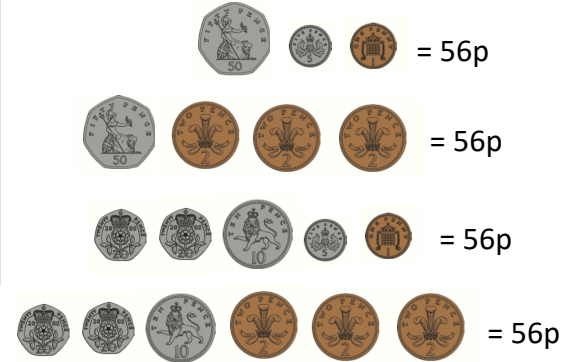
Count money



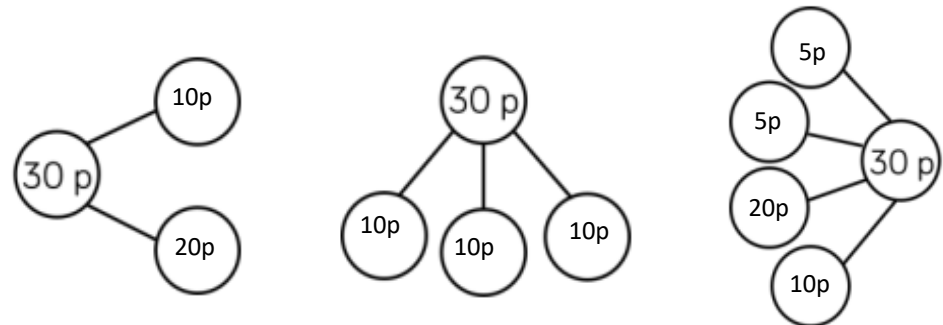
When counting notes and coins, count the pounds first.

Select Money / Make the same amount

When you have a selection of coins. There is often lots of different ways to make the same amount.



Put £13 and 40p into the purse



Compare money

I have £38

I have 38p

£38 is greater because each pound is worth 100p



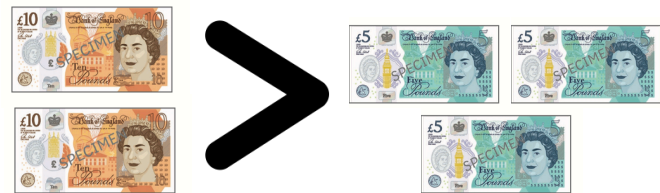

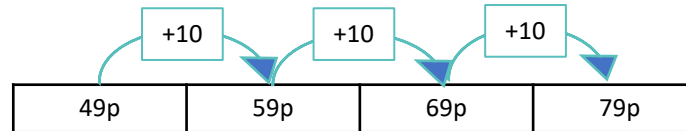
Use your addition knowledge to add amounts of money together

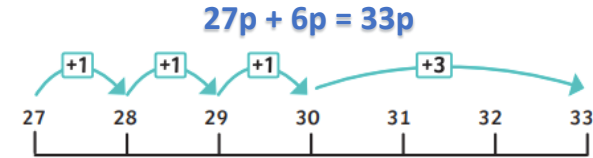

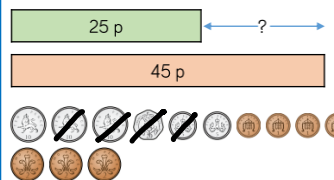

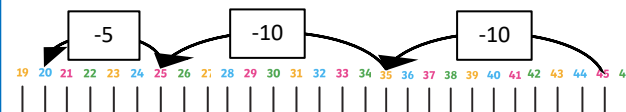
