This shows help available such as household costs, childcare costs, income boosting, energy bills, transport costs and finding work.

Two common funds we issue clients are:

The household support fund (through Coventry city council)

- this can support with energy bills, essential items including household and white goods, clothing and food vouchers

Community support grant (through Coventry city council)

- great for new tenants on a low income who can receive help with furniture/white goods

There's so many grants we also have access to depending on the need of the clients and what criteria they meet. We also issue food vouchers frequently to use locally.

For regular reductions on food costs which have increased lately, there is a service called the 'social supermarket' or the 'grub hub' where you can sign up and pay a weekly small amount of £4-5 to receive up to £20 worth of food.

# Are you worried about a child/childrens hearing?



Below are just a few of the signs that a child may be struggling with their hearing:



⇒ They do not reply when you call them

⇒ They talk very loudly

⇒ They ask you to repeat yourself a lot or respond differently / inappropriately to what you have asked



⇒ They increase the volume on TV/devices etc.

⇒ They appear to daydream a lot

⇒ They are slow to learn to talk/unclear when talking

⇒ They get frustrated/aggressive frequently



The School Nursing team offer Audiology (hearing) screening for all Reception class pupils.

These are carried out as monthly clinics at two different locations. Ask parents to get in touch with the School Nursing team on one of our contact numbers or email addresses below to book a test.

If you have concerns about an older child/ren's hearing, ask parents to call the Central Booking number to make an appointment with the Audiology department directly on 0300 200 0011. If parents wish they can have Reception children tested here too.
