Every Child, Every Day, Every Chance this week:

We have at least 10 children at Templars with serious food allergies and the consequences of contact with their allergens could be very, very grave. We are a nut free school and this includes sesame seeds, peanut butter and Nutella. Please **DO NOT** send these foods to school and it is also important that both school and home teach children to not share or swap foods.

It is a requirement that grapes and cherry tomatoes are cut in half—we have already had a choking incident this term with uncut grapes. A huge thank you and well done to Freddie in 1C for alerting an adult who was able to help very quickly.

Our school chef, Michelle and her team are excellent at providing meals for pupils with special dietary needs and the quality, variety and portion size of meals is fantastic. We are proud to offer hot, nutritious meals especially during the cold winter months at £2 a day, a price well below the norm for school dinners. Family Learning Coventry Adult Education Service

Free, downloadable, online courses for parents/carers with children in Coventry Primary Schools or Nursery Settings.

Family Learning is part of Coventry City Council and we provide workshops and courses for Coventry parents/carers. These are our three, autumn term, online courses:

- English in the Primary School - recorded online sessions course code FL22517
- Maths in the Primary School - recorded online sessions course code FL22516

These two courses tell you more about what our children learn at school and how you can help at home.

- Positive Family Foundations - recorded online sessions course code FL22505

This course tells you about how children develop, and looks at practical examples around raising well-behaved, happy, safe and secure children.

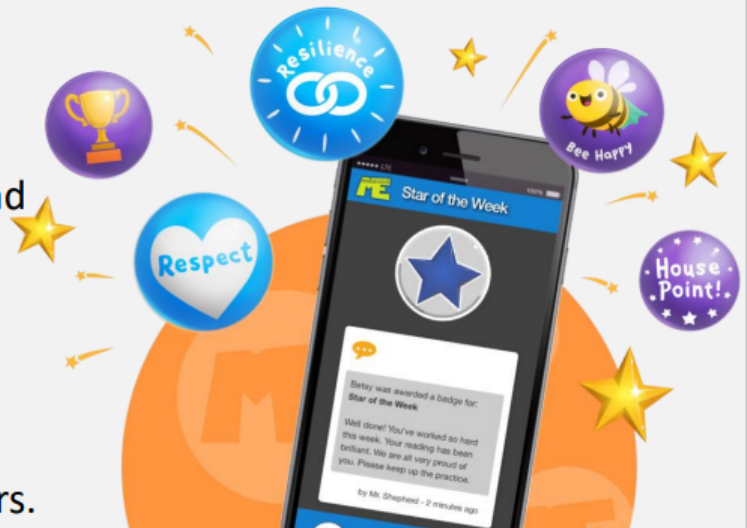

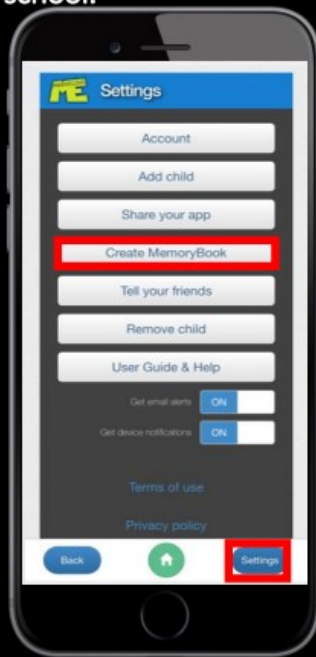
