I shall be keeping an eye on your news and developments over the forthcoming years and I know that with everyone's continuing support, the school will continue to flourish and make memories for generations to come.

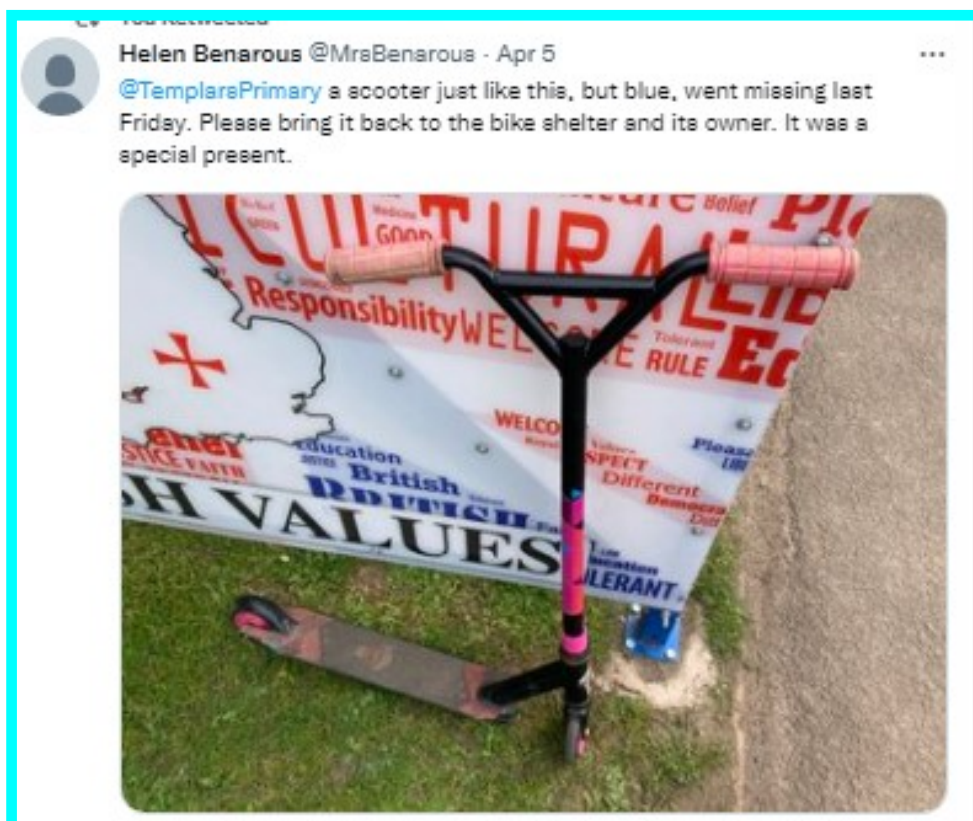

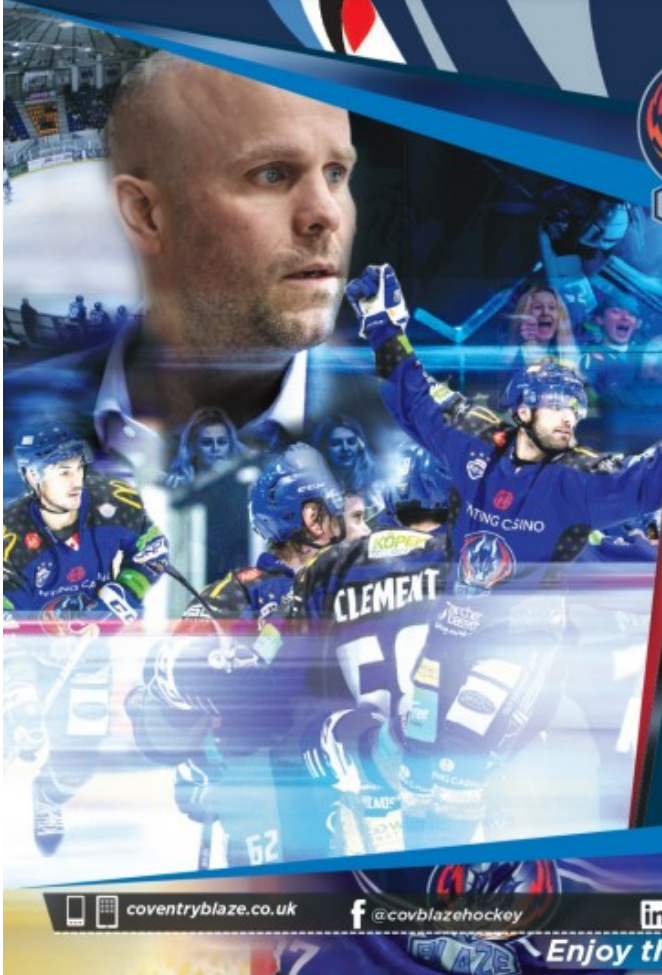
