Dear Parents and Carers,

This week we have seen the first really bad weather of the year. Like many other schools we have been struggling to get supplies of grit for the pathways so I would like to thank you all for taking extra care when coming to school this week.

If we do have bad weather we will always do all we can to keep the school open. In the unlikely event of the conditions being too dangerous we will use the website, local radio and Marvellous Me to let you know.

Normally at the end of the Autumn term we would be having Nativity plays and Christmas Fairs but this year, like last year, we will be doing things differently. We are still hoping to invite parents into school for special 'Be Our Guest' events but these will be on a smaller scale - with the classes doing individual events. More details will follow. For everyone's safety please do not attend if you are feeling unwell, and you will be required to wear a facemask in the school building unless exempt. We are watching the news carefully, and plans may have to change last minute if we get revised guidance from the Local Authority or government.

On Friday 10th December we will be having a non-uniform day, where children may wear non-uniform in exchange for providing an item for the Christmas bottle tombola. Bottles can be wine, spirits, toiletries, soft drinks, jars of fruit etc.

The final week of term will be full of Christmas festivities.

On Tuesday 14th December (and Wednesday 15th if needed) we will hold a Christmas bottle tombola on the playground from 3.15pm

On Wednesday 15th December the whole school will have the opportunity to have a Christmas dinner. These must be ordered in advance for KS2 children.

Thursday 16th December is Christmas activity fun day for all classes and the final Friday will be Christmas jumper day where the children can wear a Christmas jumper instead of a school top. (Normal uniform trousers or skirts and school shoes must still be worn).

During the week Father Christmas will be visiting all the classes.

Christmas School Dinner – Wednesday 15th December 2021

We would like to give every child here at Templars the opportunity to have a Christmas Dinner at school, even if your child usually brings a packed lunch.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 Children

For Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children, we are asking parents to confirm with their Class Teacher if they **DO NOT** wish their child to receive a Christmas dinner, and that they will send their child in with a packed lunch on that day. This is because all children in these classes are entitled to a Universal Free School Meal, which means you will not be charged for this meal. We will provide a meal for your child unless you inform us otherwise.

Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 Children

For years 3, 4, 5 and 6 we would ask that parents pay £2 in advance on Parent Pay with a comment in the notes stating Christmas Dinner. No payment is required if your child is on Free School Meal.

For children who do not wish to have a Christmas Dinner, please ensure that your child comes to school with a packed lunch on this day. If you know in advance that your child will not wish to have a Christmas Dinner, please could ask them to inform their Class Teacher.

The menu for Christmas Dinner Day is as follows:

GREEN OPTION

Roast Turkey, Pigs in Blanket with Potatoes, Seasonal Vegetables and Gravy (Halal Option Available)

BLUE OPTION

Quorn Roast, Vegetarian Pigs in Blanket with Potatoes, Seasonal Vegetables and Gravy

PUDDING CHOICES

Mince Pie with Cream or Custard

Ice Cream Christmas Tree

Christmas Pudding with Custard
