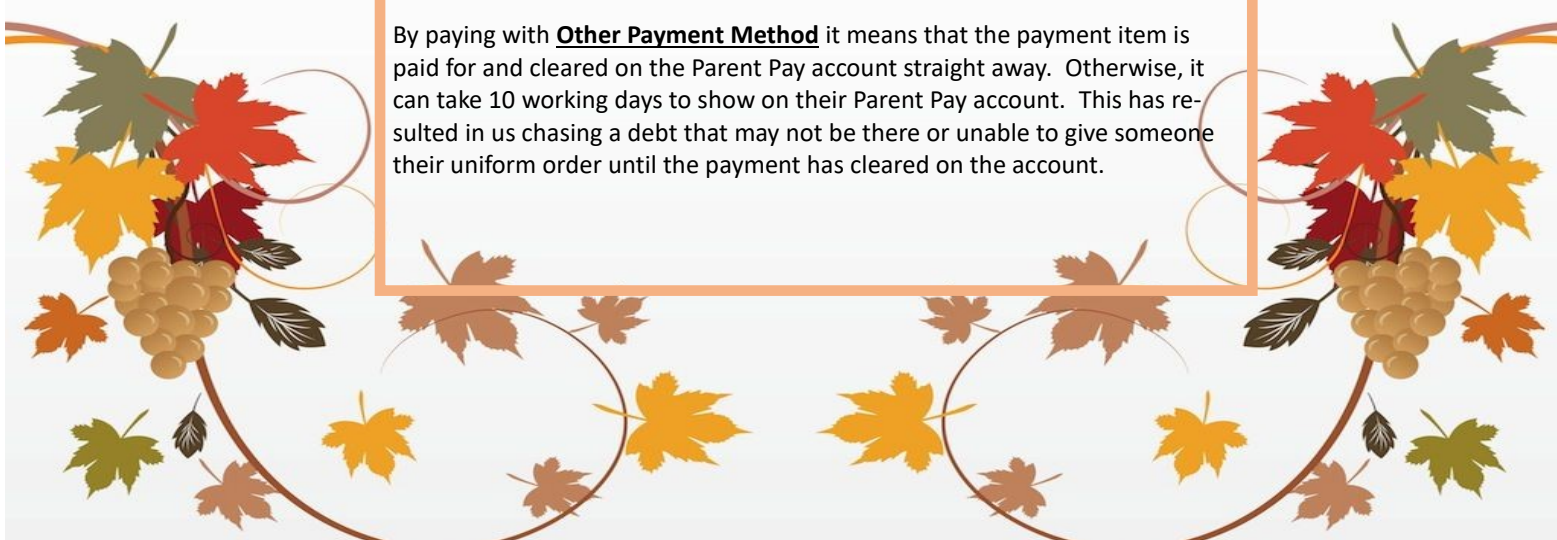

MAKING PAYMENT ON PARENT PAY

When paying for any of the services e.g School Meals, Out of Hours School Clubs, Trips etc please can you add the payment item to the basket they wish to purchase and then make the payment via **Other Payment Method** and not via Bank Transfer or VISA.

By paying with **Other Payment Method** it means that the payment item is paid for and cleared on the Parent Pay account straight away. Otherwise, it can take 10 working days to show on their Parent Pay account. This has resulted in us chasing a debt that may not be there or unable to give someone their uniform order until the payment has cleared on the account.
