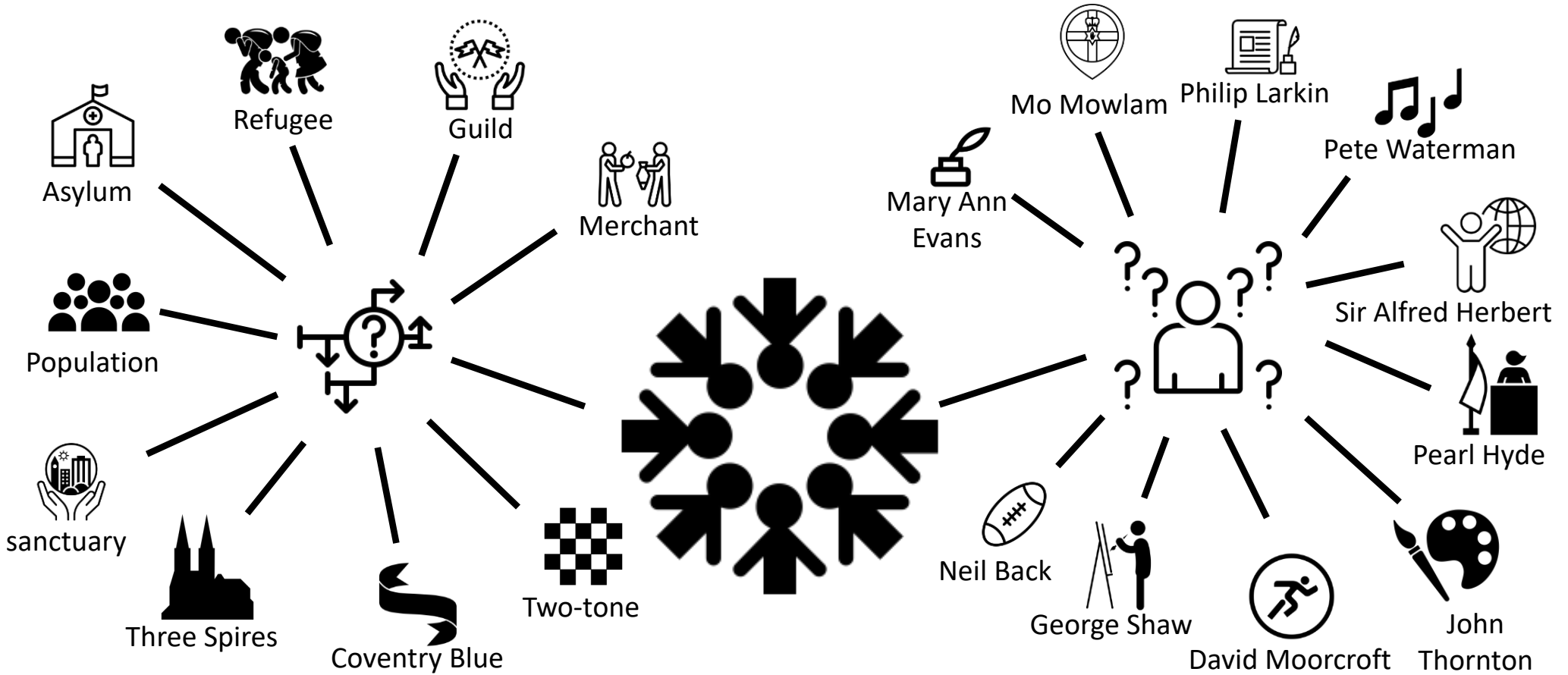
Mary Ann Evans	Real name of 'George Eliot' the author
