









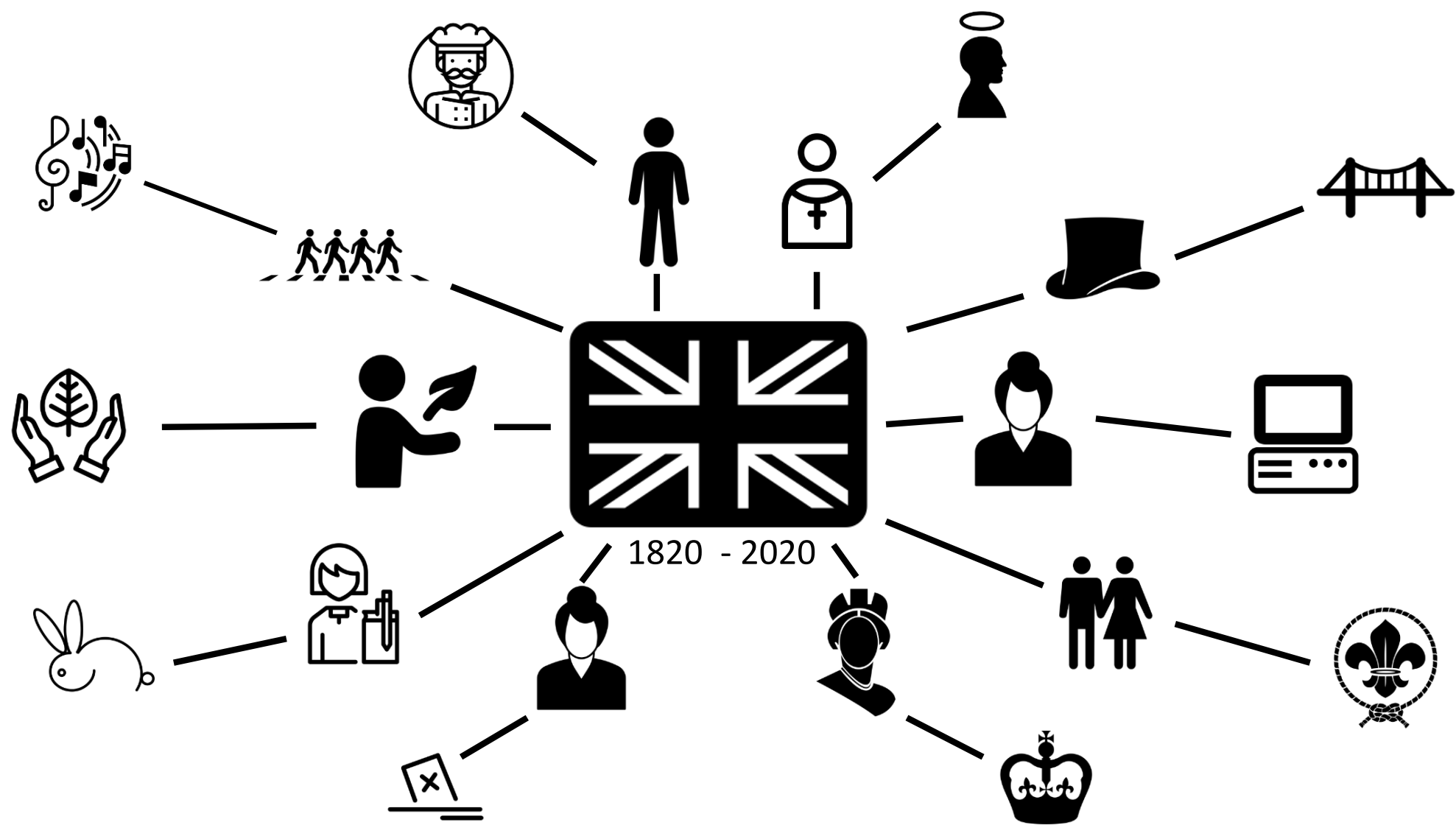


**Prior knowledge**

<p>Cardinal John Henry Newman 1801 - 1890</p>	<p>Very influential Catholic priest and Cardinal who was canonised by the Pope in October 2019</p>	
<p>Isambard Kingdom Brunel 1806 - 1859</p>	<p>An Engineer who designed railways and bridges that are still in use today.</p>	
<p>Ada Lovelace 1815 - 1852</p>	<p>The first person to recognise the full potential of computers and one of the first computer programmers.</p>	
<p>Lord &amp; Lady Baden-Powell Lord: 1857 – 1941 Lady: 1889 - 1977</p>	<p>Founded the scout and guide movement</p>	
<p>Queen Victoria 1819 - 1901</p>	<p>Queen of England from 1837 until she died in 1901.</p>	
<p>Emmeline Pankhurst 1858 - 1928</p>	<p>Suffragette and campaigner for equal rights for women including the right to vote.</p>	
<p>Beatrix Potter 1866 - 1943</p>	<p>Author and illustrator of books whose main characters are animals.</p>	
<p>Sir David Attenborough 1926 -</p>	<p>Television broadcaster and writer specialising in the natural world.</p>	
<p>The Beatles Paul McCartney: 1942 – John Lennon: 1940 – 1980 Ringo Starr: 1940 - George Harrison: 1943 - 2001</p>	<p>An English rock band formed in Liverpool in 1960 and thought to be the most influential band of all time.</p>	
<p>Jamie Oliver 1975 -</p>	<p>British chef and restaurateur who is well known for his campaign for healthier school dinners.</p>
